

SPILL RESPONSE

Matrix provides emergency spill response out of strategic office locations across Western Canada: Fort St. John, Grande Prairie, Edmonton, Calgary, Medicine Hat, Lloydminster, Weyburn, Swift Current, Oxbow and Brandon. Matrix's spill response service includes developing a pragmatic spill response strategy that accounts for site specific conditions including the likely end of outcome at the early stages of spill response to implement an appropriate strategy. The result is a cost effective response tailored to client objectives and site conditions.

Based on the nature of the spill, our response services can include:

- GIS-supported data gathering to quickly determine risk to receptors such as water-bodies;
- On-site testing to separating impacted soil and water from clean soil and water to minimize trucking and disposal costs;
- Integrating operational pipeline repair efforts with environmental emergency spill response activities;
- Assisting with the transition from emergency spill response to environmental assessment and remediation;
- Acting as a regulatory, stakeholder and landowner liaison;
- Providing regulatory reporting; and
- Developing regional spill response strategies that account for conditions such as soil type, natural soil salinity and receptor risk to guide future emergency spill responses conducted by Matrix or other service providers.
